Although a mile long, the famous “dredge pile pyramids” were hauled away and the entire reach re-contoured for a fraction of the cost. The key was that Harper excavation won the bid and re-cycled the sand and gravel dredge spoil at a profit. South Jordan City dedicated a 150-foot river buffer setback.
